Overview

The Sacramento County Management Association was elected the exclusive representative of the Attorney-Civil and Management Units in elections held on April 30, 2010. This report requests approval of the resolution granting official recognition to the Sacramento County Management Association.

On April 30, 2010, representation elections were held in the Attorney-Civil and Management Units. Adoption of this resolution will provide for recognition of SCMA as the exclusive representative of the Attorney-Civil and Management Units effective May 23, 2010.
